This meeting is **mandatory** for all IB Seniors as it pertains to testing protocol, uploads for IB, exam procedures and IB/AP rules and regulations. Also, each student will receive his/her personal testing schedule. I strongly encourage you, as a parent of an IB senior, to view the information on kingib.org as it will be posted. I will be available for parent conferences via phone or in person for questions.

I would also like to alert you to some important "housekeeping" items to be completed by your student before he/she takes his/her IB and AP exams. In order to facilitate this process, Mrs. Barnes and Mrs. Stubbs will be visiting the senior English classes in April. Listed below is a list of the items and/or information that they will need from your student:

- The **complete** mailing address of the college or university your student will attend,
- A **copy** of the acceptance letter or email from the school the student plans to attend,
- A list of **All** scholarship offers received. Please know the amount the student would receive each year, the total amount, whether the scholarships are renewable, if it is a one-time scholarship, if it is college based academic, athletic, or a fine arts scholarship or if it's from a private organization (this information is important, even if you *are not* accepting the scholarship).

Any assistance that you are able to provide in obtaining these items will be greatly appreciated. If scholarship offers are received after the above date, please forward the information to Mrs. Stubbs, as she will continue to update your student's record.

Also, we are requesting that you bring \$15 (cash, money order or check) to the meeting to cover the costs of IB cords for graduation and mailing of IB diplomas in the summer. Checks can be made out to King High School.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation and your continued support of not only your student, but the IB Programme at King. I look forward to seeing each of you at the Senior Banquet (May 23) and graduation (May 29).
