CAS - Creativity, Activity, Service

CAS is the "active" component of an IB student's education. It combines aesthetic, athletic, creative and service-minded experiences outside of the classroom **and is a graduation requirement for all IB Students.**

The homeroom teacher serves as the CAS Advisor and should be the first point of contact with questions/concerns regarding CAS. Students and Advisors use Managebac, an online tracking system to add CAS experiences, hours and reflections as they complete each of the CAS strands. Students are registered as freshmen, and receive an email with log in information. Students who do not have access to Managebac should contact their HR teacher or Mrs. Barnes.

This is a gentle reminder, seniors should have at least 125 hours submitted at this time and 200 total hours prior to graduation. **All remaining CAS hours for the class of 2019 must be submitted on Managebac by April**

12. Additionally, sophomores should have 50 hours completed and entered into Managebac by the close of the school year.
