"Hey Class of 2020! After a quick conference with Ms. Oliveros, I have decided to dedicate Monday and Tuesday of next week (May 20 & 21) to intense EE work. Please come prepared with your computer, books, and any notes to complete your outline as required by Ms. Oliveros (due next Friday, May 24). I want to be very clear as to my expectations so please adhere to the following:

1. Bring everything you may need to create the outline (for real) including your computer.

2. You MUST have had that first meeting with your adviser to complete Monday/Tuesday's tasks. Please make sure you have made face to face contact with your adviser. Please make sure you have an approved topic/research question.

If you have not done this yet, do it! Just move forward...no big deal.

3. Please use this weekend to gather your materials and research your sources. This MUST be done so you can work efficiently on Monday/Tuesday. I want to be clear that Monday and Tuesday are NOT for you to BEGIN but rather for you to CONTINUE your work. For this reason, your sources must be located and accessible. Create a source page and annotate each source with your intended use for that source (in other words, an annotated bibliography).

4. I will be available for assistance. I will also have handouts available for outlining instructions and tips.

5. By the end of Monday and Tuesday, I expect you to have a finished outline and an opening paragraph for your EE ready to print and turn in to Ms. Oliveros by the end of the week. ADDITIONALLY, you are to go into

Managebac (that day) and type a thorough reflection about your experience thus far. This will be Reflection 1. Note: ALL this is to be completed by the end of class Monday and Tuesday.

6. Wednesday and Thursday of next week, May 22 and 23, you will write an essay in class for your final exams.


