forward to serving you next year!

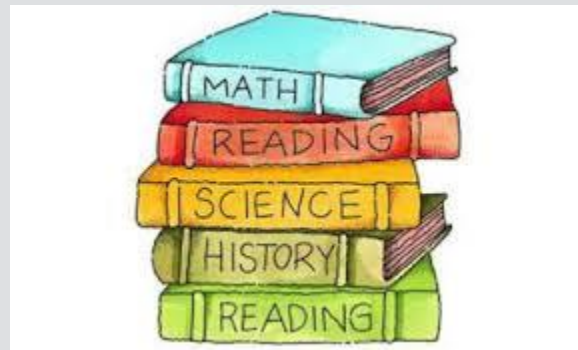
